LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR THE LGBTQIA+ COMMUNITY AT WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY

Dear campus community,

As representatives of Wayne State's diverse student body, we are responsible for representing their voices on matters that impact our community.

Wayne State's Student Senate affirms our commitment to the creation and sustaining of a campus environment which is affirming and safe, where all students, regardless of gender identity or expression can thrive academically, socially, and personally.

The last few years have seen a record number of bills to limit transgender rights. In 2024 alone, 674 bills were introduced and considered that would limit transgender rights.¹² We are also now seeing legislation and rhetoric which is attempting to deny the existence of intersex conditions and the people who have them.³

We emphasize that these policies are not based on solid scientific research but rather on misinformation and political agendas that ignore the overwhelming body of medical and psychological evidence supporting the rights and wellbeing of transgender and intersex individuals.⁴⁵⁶⁷ To our transgender and intersex students: you are valid, and your identity is real. Science affirms your validity, recognizing that gender diversity is a natural and important part of the human experience. You are valued members of our community, and your presence enriches our campus in countless ways. We encourage you to embrace your worth and know that you deserve respect, affirmation, and support.

We recognize the unique challenges that transgender and intersex students are currently facing, including discrimination, lack of adequate resources, and barriers to full participation in campus life. We acknowledge the importance of advocating for policies and practices that support their well-being and success. This includes access to gender-affirming healthcare, inclusive housing and facilities, chosen name and pronoun recognition, and protection from discrimination and harassment.

In short, the Senate stands by our campus community in this time of uncertainty. You will see attached to this email campus and community resources. **Please utilize them as need arises**.
