- A. Guest Speaker: Diana Goode – Senior Associate Vice President of Budgets, Planning, and Fiscal Operations and Jeff Bolton
1. Budget.wayne.edu for more information
 2. Budget book/FY 2017
 - i. Revenue- \$987m separated into General Fund Budget (unrestricted), Designated Fund Budget (donor has say—specific), Auxiliary Fund Budget (ex- housing, rec centers, parking which have their own revenue stream) and Restricted Budget (25% of total revenue which have some type of condition/attachment in order to get the donation)
 - ii. FY2011- State appropriations (money from the state) covered 2/3 of University costs and Tuition/fees covered around ¼ of costs. FY2017- State appropriations now covers around 1/3 of costs and tuition covers approx. 2/3 costs
 - iii. Revenues vs Expenditures – Compensation (64%), Operating Expenses (17), Facilities (7), and Financial Aid (11)
 - iv. Who decides where these expenditures are going? The Budget Planning Council: Co-Chairs- Provost and CFO, Members- 2 Deans, 2 BAO's, 4 Faculty, 2 Students, VP, and Academic Affairs, Budget Office
 - v. Plateaued Tuition- question of whether the tuition should be the same regardless of amount of credits 12-18
 - vi. Simplify allocation- giving revenue to the specific class instead of which school/department the student is from. That way different students are not paying different rates for same class (goal is to do this within 2 years)
 - vii. WSU held to higher level (like UofM and MSU) because it is a top Research University in the state/country
