- A. Jasmine- Finance and Budget open house meeting. Meeting was focused mostly on how University wants to make housing/tuition better. Getting large enough janitorial staff for the new building. Issue of parking- lot 41 torn down to create new housing; there should be enough space in lot 6 as well as making structure 1 24 hours. Green space from Deroy getting knocked down. Tuition increase (3.8%). However, parking fees will be going down 25%

In regards to the gardens, there has not been any consistent student leadership on those projects. DS working with a group called "students feeding students" about garden space and growing food since we lost farmer's market sponsorship.
- B. Don- School of Medicine updates. Wayne State is affiliated with the DMC right now. Talks have been going on (email sent from

med school dean) that Henry Ford is now taking the bulk of medical rotations. Not cutting off completely from DMC though. National Vice Speaker of the AMA chosen from WSU. 2<sup>nd</sup> years about to take steps, 3<sup>rd</sup> years done with the year.

- 1. Not good to move to Henry Ford right? Good for the school financially and good learning for students but not as good for the med students facility wise
- 2. Distance concern- shuttle; DMC has around half students and Henry Ford has less than half. So it won't be an overwhelming change to Henry Ford while still significant.
