A resolution supporting the expansion of the Menstrual Product Program. Presented on the 7th of December 2023.

THE WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE ENACT:

WHEREAS, Student health is a priority for the University and imperative for their successful learning and involvement in the campus community; **AND,**

WHEREAS, Previous efforts of the Student Senate, outlined in, “A [*resolution supporting the development of a Menstrual Product Pilot Program*](#),” and University be maintained and expanded upon to reflect growth trends; **AND,**

WHEREAS, Facilities Planning and Maintenance have discovered a higher demand from students to expand the Menstrual Product Program; **AND,**

WHEREAS, The demand for more costless menstrual products is necessary on campus; **AND,**

WHEREAS, In an effort to access and address this need the Wayne State University Student Senate has been working with Facilities to expand the Menstrual Product Program which currently includes General Lectures, Old Main, Scott Hall, State Hall, the Undergraduate Library, Student Center and Mazurek; **AND,**

WHEREAS, The Menstrual Product Program, will provide dispensers in locations on the Medical School campus, Mike Ilitch Campus, Law School, gender neutral restrooms, STEM building and other major buildings that face such a demand with free and sustainable menstrual products (pads and tampons) for students; **AND,**

WHEREAS, The products will continue to be purchased from Aunt Flow, an organization committed to ensuring everyone has access to organic menstrual products. All their products are 100% organic cotton and biodegradable. Aunt Flow's dispensers are ADA-compliant and hold 50 pads and 50 tampons at a time; **AND,**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wayne State University Student Senate calls upon facilities to expand the original initiative and install more machines; **AND,**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wayne State University Student Senate calls on the University to allocate further funds to expand this program in additional locations that are frequently used by students; **AND,**

AND FINALLY, BE IT ORDERED, that the Wayne State University Student Senate will circulate this resolution to all relevant outlets, including the University President, the University Provost, the members of the Board of Governors, Business and Operations, the President of the Wayne State University Academic Senate, and The South End student newspaper.
